Later a filmmaker in America, Richter is known for 8x8: A Chess Sonata, a collaboration with Max Ernst, Jean Cocteau, Alexander Calder, and Marcel Duchamp, partly filmed on the lawn at the artist's Connecticut summer house.

A necklace of this design was exhibited in "Jewelry as Sculpture as Jewelry," Institute of Contemporary Art, Boston, 1973.

Note: Pol Bury (1922-2005) began his career in the Surrealist movement, and participated with his countryman Magritte in the 1945 International Surrealism exhibition. In 1953, however, he discovered the work of Alexander Calder, and this altered the course of his career. He become a leading sculptor of the Kinetic movement, uniting his creative genius with his technical and mathematical expertise. Bury was considered the master of slow movement and meditation. His sculptures, fountains, and jewelry are intended to test the limits of perception, altering the viewer's perception of time.
